Item 01/BoS 19.02/04: To Approve the Revised Syllabus of B.Com V & VI semester Core Courses, Elective Courses and Skilled Based Courses:

- In V semester, in the course Corporate Accounting (AC1751) theory part of Debentures can be included in Unit I
- In the course Income Tax Law& Practice, IV unit can be divided into two ie (one is Business or Profession and another one is Capital Gain). IV Unit can be Income from Business or Profession and V Unit can be Capital Gain. Unit V can be taken to the VI Semester. This course can be titled "Income Tax Law & Practice - I"
- In VI Semester the course, Fundamentals of Financial Management can be taken out and, in that place, Income Tax Law and Practice – II can be introduced.
- · In the course, Management Accounting, II Unit can be elaborated.
