The Board of Studies meeting held on 05/02/2019, commenced with the prayer by Dr. I. Jalaja Kumari. The Chairperson, University Nominee, Subject Experts, Alumnae, Student Representative and the Department Members were present for the meeting.

Chairperson's address

The Chairperson and Head of the Department, Dr. Regi, S., welcomed the members and introduced them while briefing on the agenda for the conduct of this meeting.

The following items in the agenda were discussed by the members of the board.

Item 01/BOS 2019 February/03: Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting held on 05/02/2018

The Chairperson and Head of the Department, **Dr. Regi, S.**, read the minutes of the previous Board of Studies meeting held on 05/02/2018 which was approved by the members of the Board of Studies.

Item 02/BOS 2019 February/04: Restructuring / Revision of Curriculum of UG

As a part of revamping of the B.A Curriculum, courses for V and VI semester have been discussed and finalized. The members accepted all the courses with some minor modifications. They are as follows:

1. In the V Semester, the course title has been changed from "History of Tamil Nadu up to 1330" to "History of Tamil Nadu up to 1336 A.D".
2. In the course title entitled "History of USA up to 1865 A.D", the board recommended to add Jeffersonian Democracy in Unit II and Thomas Manroe in Unit III.
3. In the course "History of Science and Technology (1500 A.D - 200 A.D)", the board suggested to remove the name of the philosophers like Rene Descartes, Immanuel Kant and Francis Bacon.
4. The board suggested changing of the Elective Courses of the V semester the course title from

- “History of Kanyakumari District” to “History of Kanniya Kumari District”.
5. In the same course, the year 1956 is added along with the formation of Kannyakumari District and Marshall in front of Nesamony.
 6. In the Elective Course II of the V Semester, in Unit V, NATO, SEATO, CENTRO and ANZUS Pact was removed.
 7. In the Elective Course III of the V semester, the board suggested to add the specific years along with the revolutions.
 8. In the Skilled Based Course, the board suggested to add National Symbols in Unit IV and Unit V.
 9. In the course “Contemporary History of India Since 1948 A.D” the Board suggested to add Chandrayan in Unit V after Mangalyan.
 10. In the course “History of Tamil Nadu 1336 A.D - 2011 A.D” the board suggested to include the relevant years.
 11. In Unit V, Tamil Nadu under Rajaji is changed as Tamil Nadu under Congress – Rajaji and Bakthavatchalam has been included before Kamaraj.
 12. In the III and IV Units of the course “History of USA 1865 AD – 2010 AD”, the Board suggested to have the full names of the presidents.
 13. In the course “Historiography” in the VI Semester, some rearrangements are suggested.
 14. In the first Elective “Archaeology” Kheezhadi is to be included.
 15. As far as the SBC of the VI Semester is concerned, the Board suggested to have the following corrections.
 - a) To re arrange the topics into chronological order.
 - b) Include folk music and folk dance in Unit III.
 - c) Include Development in the field of sports in Unit V
