Unit III -Blood Composition, excretory organs in invertebrates(added), Bioluminescence(deleted)

Unit IV –Reflex action. Receptors: Types, Physiology of photoreception and Phonoreception (added).

Unit V -Hormones and Pheromones, Biological clock and biological rhythms(added).

2. The course, Developmental Zoology (ZC1752) is updated by introducing the following topics in the respective Units.

Unit II - Stem cells and transplantation

Unit III - Placental preservation

Unit IV - Regeneration of human liver

Unit V – Causes of Infertility and diagnostic parameters of infertility, hormonal Imbalance and Polycystic Ovarian Disease. Hormonal and therapeutic methods.

3. The course Ecology and Toxicology (ZC1753) is updated to give more importance to employability and cross cutting issues like Environmental sustainability.

Unit II – Secondary antibody, purification of antibody using protein A/G is added.

Unit IV - Synthetic Biology is added.
