The meeting commenced at 2:00 pm. Principal Dr. Sr. Anne Perpet Sophy welcomed all the members. The Controller of Examinations briefed the agenda and the following matters were discussed during the meeting.

HAC/21 /2 Item No: 1 Minutes of the previous meeting

The minutes of the previous meeting held on 12-10-2020 was presented by the Controller of Examinations for approval.

It was resolved to approve the minutes of the Award committee meeting held on 12-10-2020.

HAC/21 /2 Item No: 2 Action taken report of the meeting held on 12-10-2020

The Action taken report of the meeting held on 12-10-2020 was presented for approval.

The members noted the Action taken report of the meeting held on 12-10-2020.

HAC/21 /2 Item No: 3 Presentation of November 2020 Semester Examination results

The Controller of Examinations presented the UG, PG and private candidates result of the semester exams held from 01-12-2020 to 31-12-2020. A total of 2542 students appeared for the exam under 266 regular and 131 arrear codes and 97. 20 % result was obtained.

It was resolved to approve the results of the UG, PG and private candidates semester exams held from 01-12-2020 to 31-12-2020 and to officially publish the results.

HAC/21 /2 Item No: 4 Result Analysis

The CoE presented the pass percentage of UG, PG and private candidates and the reasons for failure in examination were also discussed.

- IUG 95.26%, IIUG 98.55%, IIIUG 98.01%
- IPG 97.97 % IIPG 98.31%
- Private 83.78 % Total 97.20%

. Discussions on Result analysis:

The controller of examinations explained the reason for the failure of students. One observation was that the students failed to attempt all the questions and the other due importance was not given for internal examination. The reduction in pass percentage of private candidates may be an assumption by the students that all would be declared pass only by just attempting the exam.

HAC/21/2 Item No: 5 Presentation of April 2020 special supplementary results

In the April 2020 special supplementary examination for arrear students 487 students under 967 codes appeared for the examination and 455 students have passed in the examination.

Discussion on special supplementary examination:

The University nominee enquired about the special supplementary examination and whether it is conducted for students those who have failed in only in one subject.

The CoE explained about the special supplementary examination. In view of COVID 19 the Govt. Of Tamilnadu declared that all students who have applied for arrear

examination would be given a pass and as per the direction of Manonmaniam Sundaranar University the students were given a pass with 40% of marks. Since the High Court failed to accept the decision of the Government and made it mandatory that exams should be conducted either online/offline, it was decided to conduct exams online for all arrear students as special supplementary examination (Improvement examination).

HAC/21/2 Item No: 6 Ratifications

The following ratifications were presented:

1. Implementation of Professional English course

The CoE informed that it has been decided to introduce the Professional English course from this academic year as per the guidelines of TANSCHE. Since the approval from the Board of studies was obtained the course will be conducted and the exams for first semester will be held in February.

The University nominee Dr. Prabakaran, enquired whether we have received communication from the University and is it mandatory for Autonomous colleges to adopt.

The CoE informed that communication was received from the University and TANSCHE has cited Professional English as a mandatory course even for Autonomous colleges.

The University nominee further said that if approval is obtained from the Staff council, Board of studies and Academic council then there is no issue in conducting the exam.

2. Conduct of M.Phil examination

The CoE informed that M.Phil examinations will begin on February 5th as the classes have begun late and results will be published as early as possible.

Remarks by the University Nominee:

The University nominee Dr. Prabakaran congratulated the Controller of Examination, Examination section staff and the Management for successfully conducting the online exam and publishing the results well in advance despite the COVID 19 pandemic.

The meeting concluded with the vote of thanks by the Controller of Examinations.
