The meeting commenced at 2:00 pm. Principal Dr. Sr. S. Sahayaselvi welcomed the members. The following matters were presented and discussed during the meeting.

#### HAC/22 /12 Item No: 1 Minutes of the previous meeting

The minutes of the previous meeting held on 11-7-2022 was presented by the Controller of Examinations for approval.

It was resolved to approve the minutes of the Award committee meeting held on 11-7-2022

#### HAC/22 /12 Item No: 2 Presentation of November 2022 Semester Examination results

The Controller of Examinations presented the results of the UG, PG, M.Phil. and private candidates for the semester exams held from 17-11-2022 to 09-12-2022. A total of 2206 students registered and 2201 appeared for the exam under 231 regular and 98 arrear codes and total pass percentage was 89.0%

It was resolved to approve the semester exam results of the UG, PG, M.Phil. and private candidate's and to officially publish the results.

#### HAC/22 /12 Item No: 3 Results

The CoE presented the pass percentage of UG, PG, M.Phil. and private candidates.

#### **Result analysis:**

The Controller of Examinations presented the reasons for the failure of students in few degree programs:

• The performance of I and II UG students is comparatively poor in the part II English, Major and Allied in few departments. The students failed to attempt all the questions and the answers written are also not appropriate.

#### Moderation

The Controller of examinations presented the moderation list and said that to maintain a minimum pass percentage of 70% a moderation of up to 10 marks was granted in few courses to 156 students who have failed in one course.

Discussion and Suggestions:

1. Moderation: The University nominees felt that the moderation can be reduced gradually and if required it can be awarded in the even semester especially for the outgoing students.

The Board decided to consider the moderation and award 5 to 10 marks in the even semester for the outgoing students, for others it would be gradually reduced and necessary remedial measures would be taken.

2. Remedial measures: The University nominee Dr. Gnana D. Hans suggested to give more importance for the writing skill and Assignments can be checked for plagiarism.

The Board accepted the suggestion and it was decided to take necessary measures to develop the writing skill of students.

3. Project: The University nominee Dr. M. Michael Babu enquired about the PG project whether it is individual or in groups. Since a group of two students jointly do the project, he suggested that PG project can be individual.

The Board decided to consider the individual PG project and this would be presented in the Academic council for the forth coming Academic year.

4. OBE attainment: The University nominees asked about OBE and the course outcome attainment.

The CoE informed that OBE is followed right from syllabus up to question paper setting following Bloom's taxonomy and Learning outcome and attainment will be carried out for the current first years.

#### 5. Other suggestions:

- Skill based course that is currently in the job market can be introduced in the curriculum and outdated courses can be removed.
- More importance can be given to Practical's at the PG level.
- Internship in reputed institutions under the guidance of the faculty.

The meeting concluded with the vote of thanks by the Controller of Examinations.

- **5.** Importance can be given to Practical's at the PG level. Since TANSCHE syllabus is followed the practicals will be as per the new syllabus.
- 6. Internship in reputed institutions under the guidance of the faculty. *The students have gone for internship in reputed institutions during this summer vacation.*
