Mentoring Clinic on Patents: A Guide to Protecting the Intellectual Property

Institution's Innovation Council in association with Holy Cross Innovation and Incubation Centre organized a Mentoring Clinic on "Patents: A Guide to Protecting the Intellectual Property" from 05-06-2023 to 07-06-2023. Ms. Meenaa Balakrishnan, IPR Attorney and Registered Patent Agent, Sprinton Law Office Law Firm, Coimbatore was the resource person. On 5th June 2023, she delivered a talk on the importance of filing the intellectual



property. Afternoon, she started the mentoring session, the research scholars, students and the faculty members came in groups and discussed their innovative ideas and the inventions. The resource person gave groupwise mentoring and shared her valuable inputs. On 6th June to 7th June 2023, the mentoring session began at 10:00 am, the IPR attorney helped the students and the faculty members for patent drafting. All the participants utilized the facilities arranged by the management and the IIC members. As a result of this mentoring event 10 utility patent, 3 design patent and one trademark were filed. Total 100 participants were participated and get benefitted from this event.

Session on Accelerators/ Incubation - Opportunities for Early-Stage Entrepreneurs

Field Visit to Micro Composting Centre, Nagercoil

A group of 50 students and two staff members for a field visit to the Micro Composting Centre. Nagercoil Corporation, Bousing Board, Nagercoil on 31-01-2024 at 11:00 am. The visit showcased the intricacies of waste management. The head of the composting centre explained the operations done in the composting



centre. The workers collected the waste from different areas and segregate in to degradable and non-

degradable wastes. All the collected wastes were dumped into the machine for further processing. The process involved systematic waste separation, waste processing, grinding, and subsequent dumping into ten dedicated tanks. These tanks facilitated the drying of the waste, demonstrating an organized approach to composting. They interacted with the workers and knew about the difficulties and the problems which the workers are facing in the composting process. The field visit provided valuable insights into sustainable waste management practices and allowed the students to witness the practical aspects of composting. Finally, in the presence of workers in the micro composting the waste and give respect to the sanitation workers. Further, they got awareness about using organic fertilizer which is prepared by this composting centre.

Session on Achieving Problem Solution Fit and Product Market Fit



World Creativity and Innovation Day




