Resource Organization Meeting

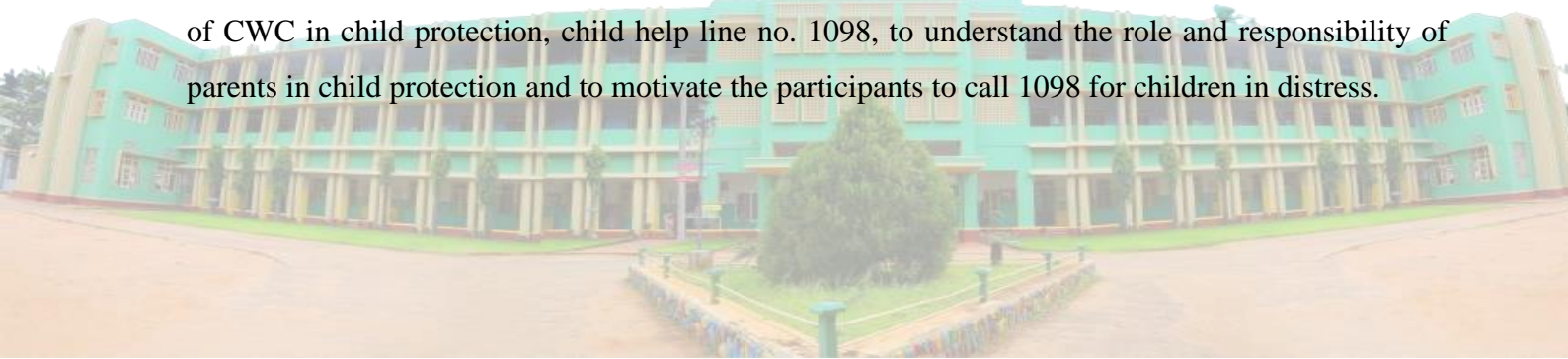

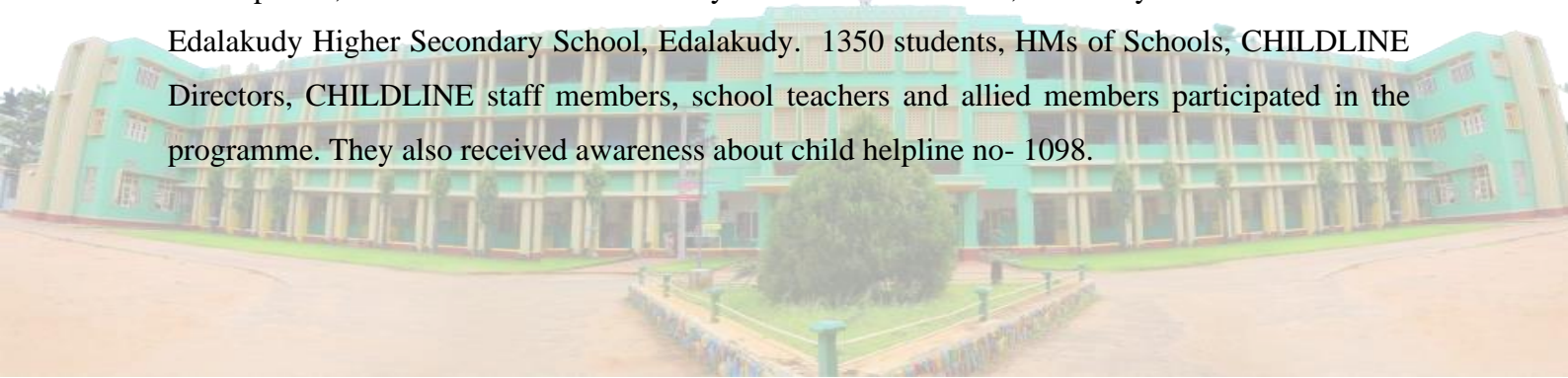


Message from District Collector

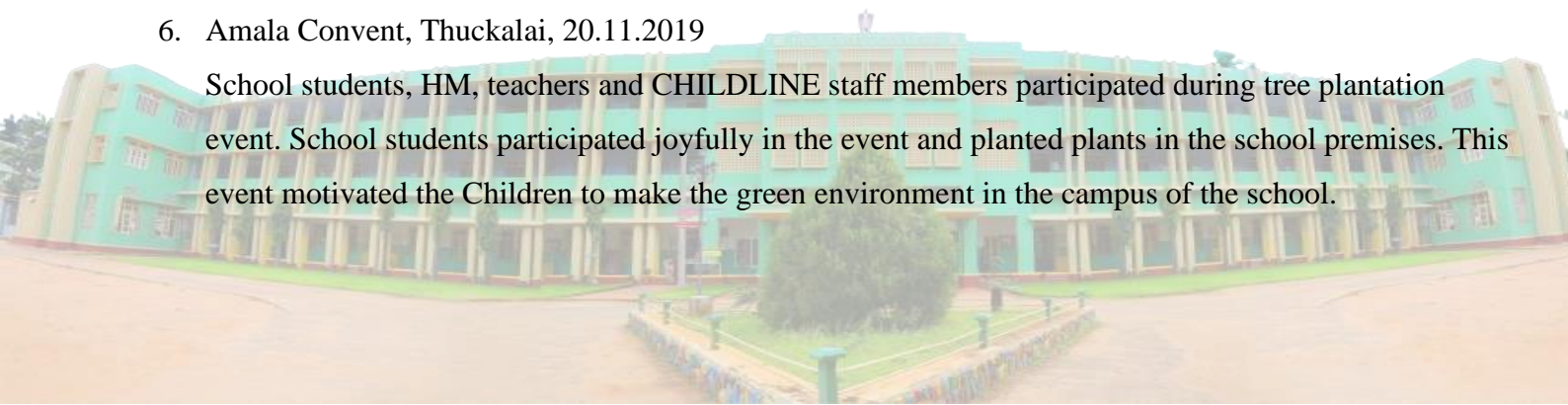


Tree Plantation:

Kid's Corner

CHILDLINE – Kanyakumari organized kid's corner for school children in SMRV school at Vadasery on 15.11.2019 and special children in Santhinilayam at Erumpukadu on 16.11.2019. CHILDLINE team organized different games such as spin game, dart game, puzzles, blind fold drawing, open canvas to draw or write something about children, photo frame, storytelling for students and their parents. 300 children participated in that programme.





Special Open House Programme

Special open house programme was organized on 20.11.2019 at Kamarajapuram Village. 29 children and 38 parents participated in that programme. Anganvadi teacher gave special talk on hygienic food and village leader explained on good health. Community members expressed the community problem that the lack of streetlight, lack of waste management and school dropouts.



Focus Group discussion

CHILDLINE-Kanniyakumari organized the focus group discussion on 20.11.2019 on child rights. 150 Students from Amala convent school at Thuckalay and 15 teachers participated in that programme. 15 students came forward for the focus group discussion. During the programme, students discussed about age of the children and their rights, about “Celebrating Children”, expectation from adults (parents, teachers, society or any other) to get children celebrated, As a Child what are the responsibilities, if any support for child is required whom they supposed to be reached? Why? (it can be parents, siblings, systems, teachers, 1098 and other mechanisms). Team member explained about CHILDLINE activities. Finally CHILDLINE-Kanniyakumari organized quiz after the group discussion. Students answered all the questions with interest.

- Information on CSA, POCSO- 2012 and Child Marriage were provided to the railway passenger, general public, parents and community members.
- 2000 Children gained knowledge and awareness on child protection and their rights.
- The various participants/ Public/other stakeholders assured the team members that they will contact and will inform child helpline no. 1098 about child in distress.
