


Outcome of the Activity : The village is illuminated by renewable energy

About 35 students actively involved themselves in the programme. 650 families are the beneficiaries of the solar lights installed in the region.






Online Sensitization Programme

To prevent child marriages in Kanniyakumari District, CHILDLINE Kanniyakumari organized Sticker Release event with the support of District Social Welfare Board on 08.10.2020.

Child Marriage issues are increasing in Kanniyakumari District. To prevent the child marriage issues, CHILDLINE-Kanniyakumari (Kottar Social Service Society and Holy Cross College (Autonomous) have prepared IEC (Information, Education and Communication) Material (ie) Stickers which have the information on components of the prohibition of child marriage act 2006 and on child helpline no. 1098. The IEC material is useful to create awareness among public on child marriage issues, so that the public gets awareness about what is child marriage, the prohibition of child marriage act 2006, offenders in child marriage issues, punishment of offence and to whom to give the information on child marriage in the society.



During the event, the allied members welcomed the Sri. Prashant M. Wadnere I.A. S District Collector. The District Collector released the sticker and pasted
