



A versex labeling $h: V(G) \rightarrow \{0, 1, 2, 3\}$ is said to be perfect mean cordial labeling of a graph G if it induces an edge labeling h' defined as follows :

$$h^{s}(uv) = \begin{cases} 1 & \text{if } 2|(h(u) + h(v)) \\ 0 & \text{otherwise} & \text{for all } uv \in E(G) \end{cases}$$

with the condition that $|e_k(0) - e_k(1)| \le 1$ and $|v_k(\alpha) - v_k(\beta)| \le 1$ for all $\alpha, \beta \in \{0, 1, 2, 3\}$, where $e_k(\delta)$ is number of edges label with $\delta(\delta = 0, 1)$ and $e_k(\lambda)$ denote the number of vertices labeled with λ ($\lambda = 0,1,2,3$). A graph G is said to be perfect mean cordial graph if it admits a perfect mean cordial labeling. In this paper, we investigate $[P_0:S_0]$ graphs are perfect mean cordial


Report on Haemoglobin Test Program at Holy Cross College (Autonomous), Nagercoil
