INTEGRATED LIBRARY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (ILMS)

The library plays a pivotal role in facilitating learning and research, catering to a diverse community of over 14,876 users, encompassing students, faculty members, researchers, nearby college students and scholars, alumni, and local residents. The HCC Library features an impressive architectural design spanning 27,097.28 square feet and is equipped with CCTV surveillance. It offers an extensive collection of arts and science resources, boasting 35,344 titles from a total of 59,593 books, along with 93 journals containing 8,048 back volumes, 16 periodicals, 3 Tamil, and 4 English daily newspapers. Additionally, we provide access to over 6,00,000+ e-books and more than 10,000+ e-journals.

The library has embraced the Open Access System, integrating a computerized circulation counter for streamlined book issuing, renewals, and returns. A convenient book drop facility is provided for students, allowing them to return books at their convenience, with records automatically updated. Seamless access to the library's extensive database, e-journals, e-books, and other electronic resources is available from any computer. To foster a culture of reading, a dedicated library hour has been incorporated into students' timetables. Over the past five academic years, the library has averaged a daily footfall of 490.41 visitors.


The software employs distinct modules for managing book transactions, including Book Issue Entry, which records issued books, and Book Receipt Entry, facilitating the management of returned books. Furthermore, newly acquired books are seamlessly integrated into the database through the Book Entry module.

The software is designed with a focus on meeting readers' needs while ensuring ease of use. Within the Online Public Access Catalog (OPAC), users can conveniently search for books using criteria such as Book Title, Subject, Publisher, Author, and via Term Search. Student and faculty library visits are efficiently tracked using RFID technology through the Gate Entry: Check in/Check out module. The system facilitates the logging of newly acquired journals through the Journal Entry feature, and departmental theses are effectively managed using the Theses Entry module. Moreover, the software empowers users to generate a variety of reports, including Student Entry Reports, Thesis Reports, Book Due Reports, Term Search, Author Search, Publisher, Accession Number, Title, and Academic Year-wise Book Reports.


The library leverages various tools to enrich its services and bolster academic support.

To combat academic dishonesty, the renowned plagiarism detection service, Drill Bit, is utilized to detect and deter plagiarism effectively. All faculty members are enrolled in Vidwan and IRINS, two pivotal platforms integral to academic pursuits. In Vidwan, faculty members










