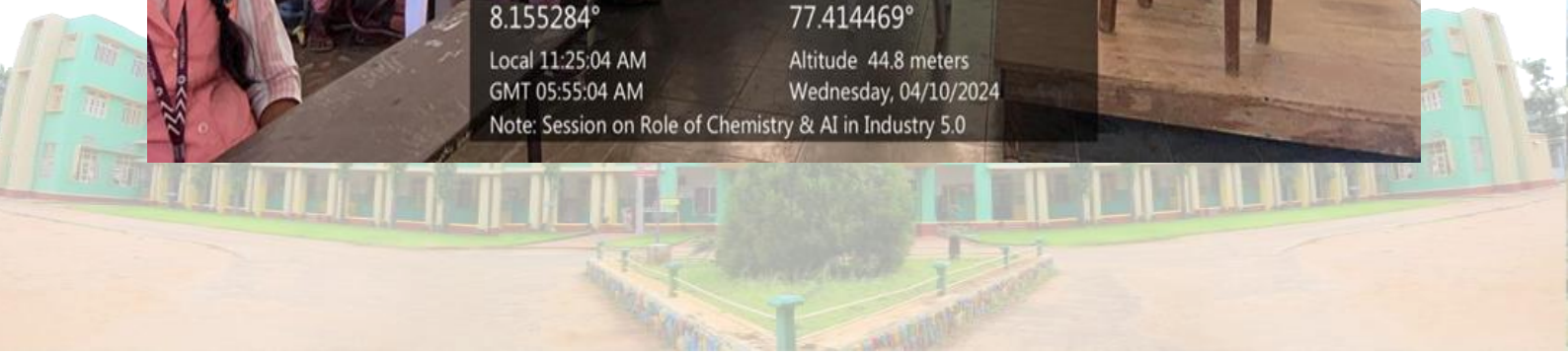

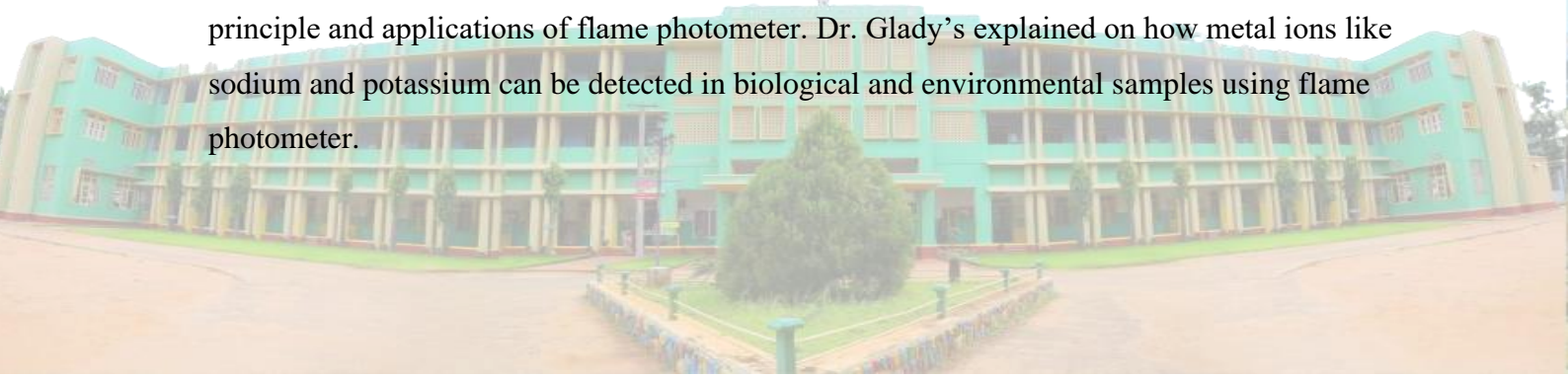



ORIENTATION PROGRAMME ON INTERNSHIP

The Department of Zoology hosted an orientation programme on "Internship" for final-year undergraduate and first-year postgraduate students September 19th, 2023. Dr. X. Venci Candida and Dr. Jeni Chandar Padua, Assistant Professors of Zoology organised the event. The resource person for the program was Dr. Parvathy Prasad, the Founder and Managing Director of Bioroot, located in Kuravankonam, Thiruvananthapuram. Dr. Parvathy Prasad provided insights into the diverse career opportunities available to life science students in fields such as Nanobiotechnology, Nanomedicine, Molecular Biology, Genetics, Cell Culture techniques, Microbiology, Immunology, and Biochemistry. She also elaborated on how internships play a pivotal role in securing employment in these domains. Additionally, Dr. Parvathy discussed Bio root's role in facilitating internships for students and the array of techniques they offer. She discussed about the hands-on training with various instruments that students would have access to during their internships. These instruments encompassed PCR, Centrifuge, UV Transilluminator, UV Spectrophotometer, Fluorescent Microscopy, Scanning Electron Microscopy, among others. Dr. Parvathy's presentation enlightened students about the significance of internships, potential industries for internship placements, and the duration of these programs. She also addressed students' queries, providing them with valuable clarifications. 35 students got benefitted.
