Vision: Coordinating activities for the welfare of students

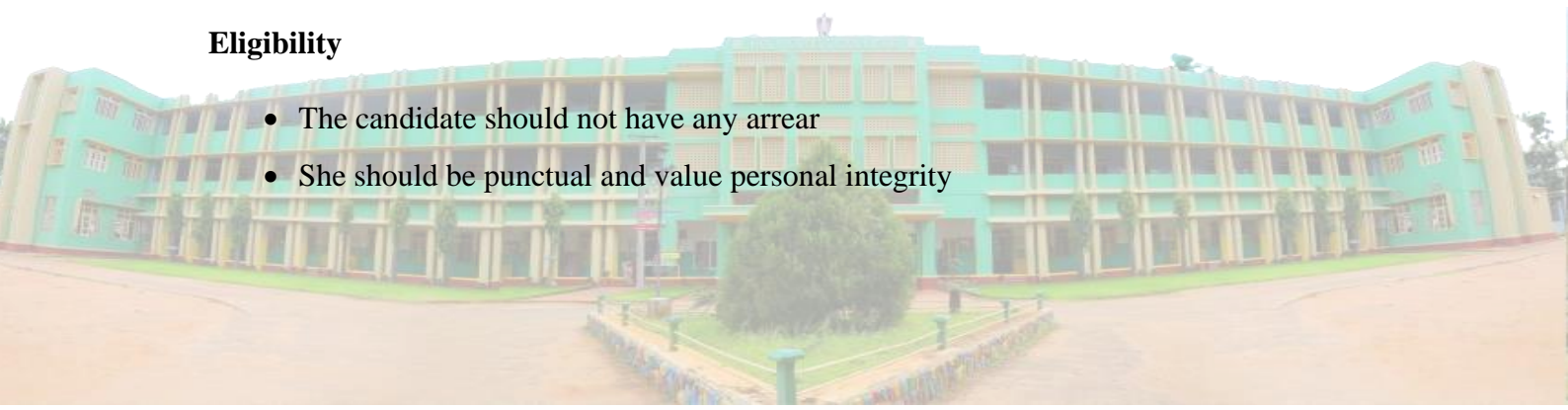
