

The Principal Dr. Sr. Basil Rose welcomed the members of the Council. Dr. Abby Grace, Dean of Arts read the minutes of the previous meeting. Dr. Basica Renuga, Dean of Science, read the orders to be followed for presenting the syllabi for approval. The syllabi for I Year VI semesters UG Programme, the change in the structure of the PG Programme and the modification in the CI course (Professional Skill in Teaching Learning) of the M. Phil programme were presented by the respective Chairperson each Board.

The recommendations and suggestions are as follows:

- * Each PSO and CO can begin with low case letters as it is the continuation of the title.
- * The instruction of passing minimum can be altered as 'A minimum of 40% in the external examination and 40% in aggregate is required'.
- * The Learning Outcome (LO) of all the practical courses can be altered as Course Outcome (CO).
- * The first and second year semester practical examinations for Computer Science, Botany and Zoology can be conducted at the end of each semester. Whereas, Physics and Chemistry practical examinations can be conducted at the



programme have to be numbered.


* Online courses opted by the students can be considered as one of the Self Learning Courses with extra credits.
