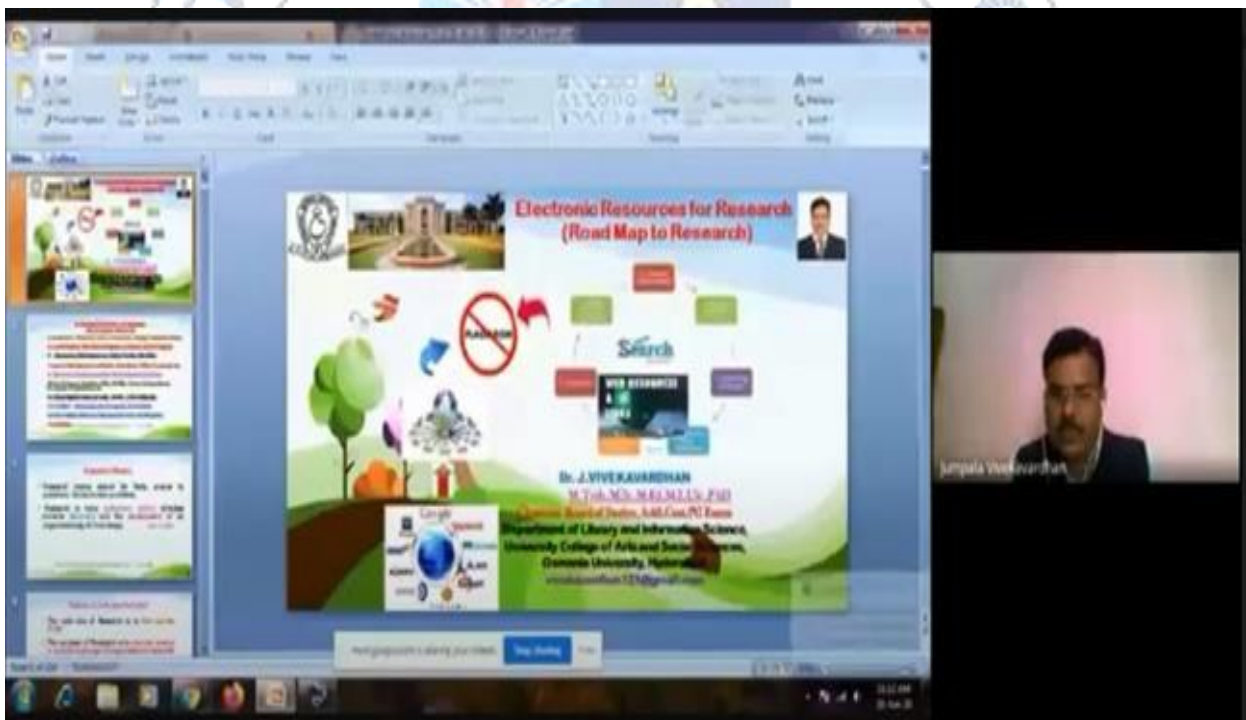

## National Webinar

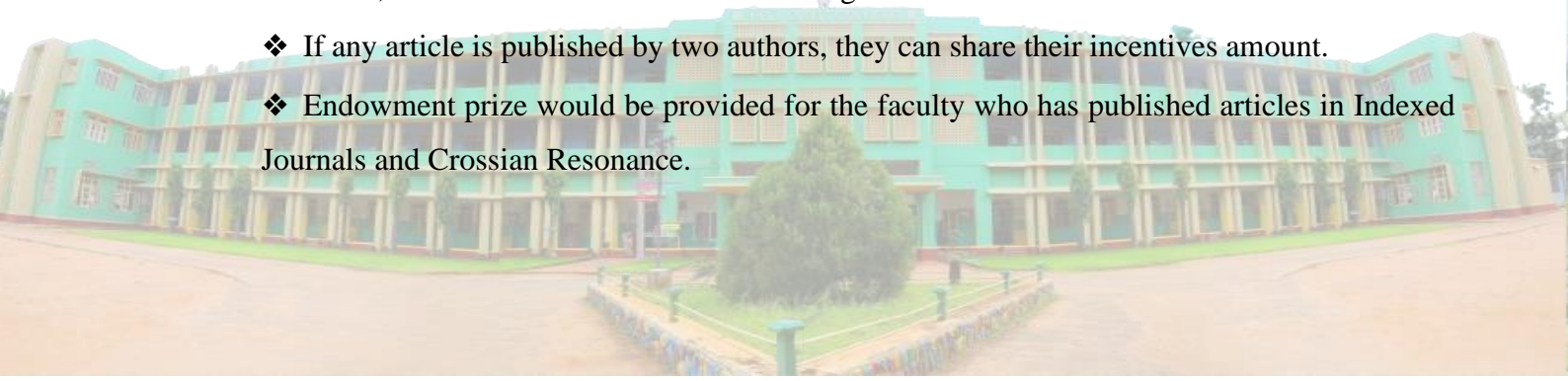

- ❖ Endowment prize would be provided for the faculty who has published articles in Indexed Journals and Crossian Resonance.

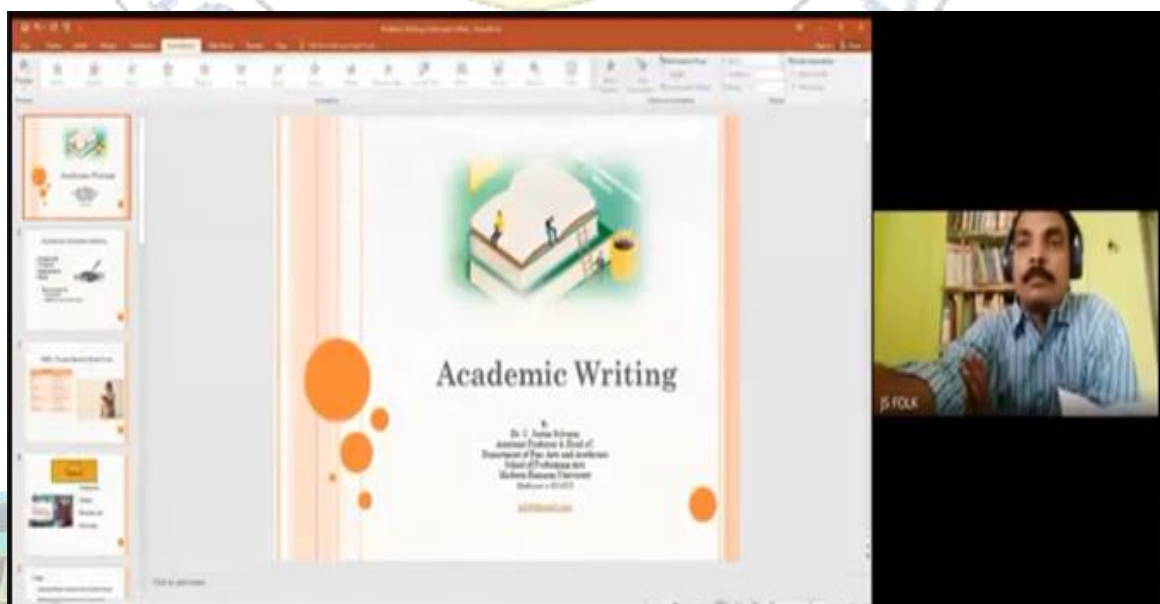


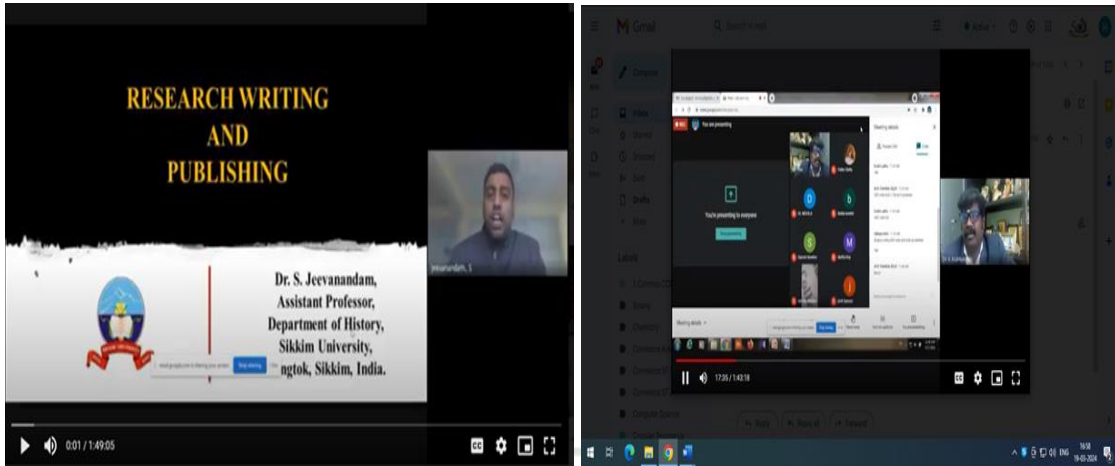
- ❖ From the academic year 2020-2021 onwards the consultancy fee had to be given to the Research Committee.
- ❖ 10% of the consultancy fees received as resource persons and Doctoral Committee members had to be given to the Research Committee.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic second wave and sudden lockdown, the incentives for the year 2019-2020 was unable to be disbursed. However, frequent online meetings were conducted on 9<sup>th</sup> April 2021, 16<sup>th</sup> April 2021 and 15<sup>th</sup> May 2021.

## Online workshop

Arul Murugan, Assistant Professor of Commerce, Pondicherry University, Karaikkal Campus , 8) Dr. Manu Mangattu, Research Consultant and Guide, Bengaluru equipped the participants with essential skills and knowledge to effectively communicate their research findings, potentially increasing the dissemination of their research work.





The Crossian Centre for Research and Development concentrates much on the enhancement of scholars and during this academic year, 8 scholars were awarded Ph.D. and 18 new scholars were enrolled.

The Crossian Centre for Research and Development also recognizes the faculty who involve themselves in attending workshops, seminars, FDP, PDP and other training programmes by providing incentives. 139 faculty members participated in Faculty Development Programmes and Management Development Programmes. 22 faculty members received financial support of Rs. 67,133/- (registration fees/travel expenses/membership fees) for participating/presenting papers in Conferences, Seminars, Workshops and Faculty Development Programmes.
