Candy talk

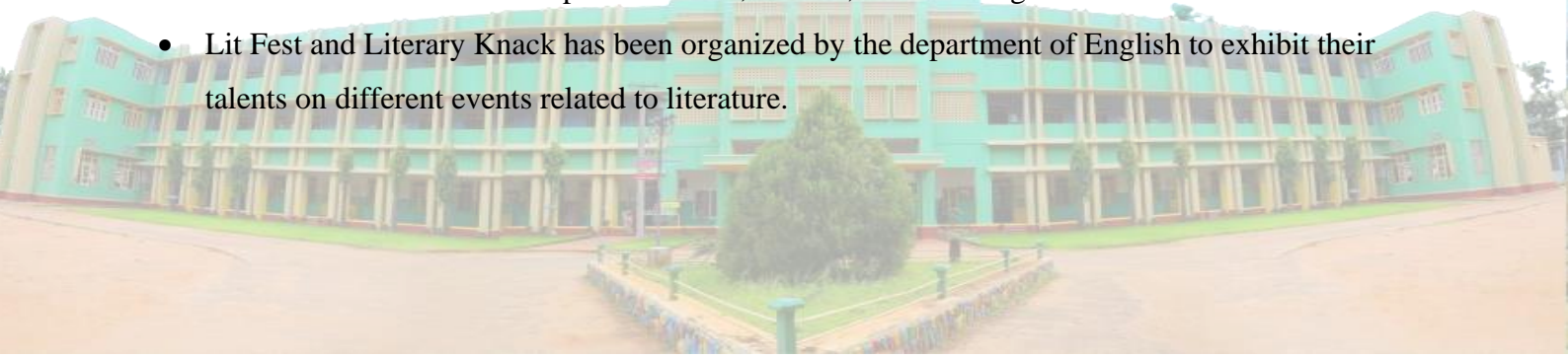

- Lit Fest and Literary Knack has been organized by the department of English to exhibit their talents on different events related to literature.





Future Plan

- The evaluation reforms could be presented in the committees right from the examination committee, curriculum steering committee and in the Academic Council for final approval.
- The course attainment calculation measures could be presented to the faculty and the students before the commencement of the examination.

Suggestions

- MOOC course is mandatory. If a student fails to clear the MOOC course, a supplementary exam should be given with a certificate from COE office and only one credit should be assigned. For a 4 week course one credit and 8 week or more, 2 credits should be awarded. A code should be assigned for supplementary exam of MOOC course.
- Examination reforms and changes in Examination pattern should be presented in the Curriculum Steering Committee, Examination Committee, Academic Council and Governing body. Minutes of all the proceeding should be maintained.
- Examination manual can be updated based on the changes made in the Academic Council every year.
- Responsibilities and regulations to be followed by the Chairman of the evaluation board, Evaluators (Internal and External) and Question setters should be documented in the Examination Manual.
- Mapping of course outcome attainment for all the programmes.
- A committee should be formulated including an external member probably a retired police or judge to deal with the malpractices of semester examinations.
- CCTV camera must be monitored daily by the Controller of Examinations.

The administrative section of Holy Cross College (Autonomous), Nagercoil, is adequately organized with sufficient number of staff to ensure seamless functioning and prompt delivery of services to the college, staff and students. Enough of space, furniture and equipment, including computers are available for efficient performance. Systems and procedures are established with the intention of dissemination of information and rendering of assistance to the different segments of the college, Government authorities and overseeing agencies and entities.

Administrative Staff

The administrative staff are enough in numbers and are trained well to carryout administrative tasks efficiently. Periodical training sessions arranged by the college have helped them to acquire comprehension and communication capabilities, IT, Internet and website handling, and office management skills.
